As a service to users, we will be updating the URLs given in the PEP books every so often. This doesn't mean that you will always find the URL given in the book when the time comes. This is not a huge disaster, it just happens.

Expert surfers may be able to find alternative ways to the vanished sites. Or they may discover good substitutes for themselves. If the worst comes to the worst, googling a key idea from the task or activity e.g. 'successful entrepreneurs', 'Scilly Isles', 'U.S. cities' or 'road charging' will usually provide a solution.
